Final Report on the Development Plan Germany 2004

The development plan Germany 2004 was started with the meeting between DUB and IFF in Weißenfels in January 2004.

The main targets for increase floorball in Germany had been:

Redoubling the number of state associations A total number of members above 3000

These targets were reached by December 31st 2004. The statistic is enclosed as enclosures No 1 and 2.

The ways to reach these targets have been as follows:

- ➤ The German Floorball Association concentrated all efforts on the at the beginning of 2004 existing structures in Nordrhein Westfalen, Baden-Würtemberg und Schleswig Holstein. We signalized the acting people, that we would be able to support them after they joined the German Floorball Association. By this way of acting, we can be sure, that the invested money of the IFF can be better controlled as when giving it to a single person. The planning concerns the second part of the IFF development money. (For details see the enclosure No 3)
- ➤ We gained a PE teacher from Sachsen, Mr. Michael Gatzke, as special representative. Mr. Gatzke has reduced his job as teacher to a part-time job and invests the free Mondays for floorball. Therefore he is supported by us with 325 € monthly all in. The demonstrating material is given by a German floorball seller, Mr. M. Blanke. By the way, Mr. Gatzke founded the state association of Sachsen.

First of all his mission is to get in contact with the educational authorities of the states to open their mind for floorball as a school sports offer. This mission seems to us so important, as we got the experience, that the efforts to influence the PE teacher with floorball have been the main reason for the extraordinary

development in Sachsen und Sachsen Anhalt.

In the beginning Mr. Gatzke has renewed the material for teaching and training purposes.

On the other hand Mr. Gatzke has to get in contact with other non sport organisations, which are spread around Germany and will offer floorball to their members. We think, that the existing clubs in the neighbourhood of those non sport organisations will profit in the way, that interested members of the organisations will join these clubs. With the German YMCA we have got a very good contact, which supports our efforts to spread floorball.

- We have supported the state associations with material support, namely for new starting club activities.
 For details see enclosure No 3
- Last but not least we support the state associations in organising tournaments for school teams. We are convinced, that these tournaments are the best way to influence young player with floorball and gain them for more playing in floorball clubs.

The concentration on existing structures was the right decision to increase the number of members quickly. The cooperation with the non sport organisation YMCA will bear remarkable fruit not before the next three years.
