1. Opening present issues

Mr. Liljelund opened the meeting at 13.00 at the SP Gothenburg Offices, Sweden

2. Last meeting

Last meeting July 2011

- Material Regulation MR2014 as approved by IFF CB sent out to the manufacturers
 - Jii-Tii Sport has paid their dues, but it is unclear if they have paid the late payments. SP to check with their financial department 0
 - Argentum has reported their sales for the season today.
 - SP has informed the new criteria's for the goalie face mask to the manufacturers in accordance with MR2014
 - SP will not make any test for full composite blades for the season 2013 2014.

New ideas for the Material Regulations •

SP to look upon a new test method for checking the bounce of the ball to classify the approved balls.

3. IFF issues

- Oxdog case
 - The IFF has been asked to compensate the withdrawal of the Oxdog OnePiece
 - There needs to be a solution in the issue. IFF/SP will formulate proposal a solution in the coming weeks.

Actions to be taken:

- SP to include a text in the agreement with the manufacturers about that by \cap signing it, they agree to follow the IFF Material Regulations.
- SP/IFF will include a risk classification of the dispenses given to the 0 manufacturers if their products don't meet the requirements.

SP – IFF Agreement 4.

- The main agreement
 - 0 is ongoing and there are no real need to make any changes.
- The appendix to the agreement between IFF and SP has been signed for 2010 2013
 - SP proposes that the SP administration cost for sales of certification labels and 0 self marking would be CHF 24.000 (2014) and CHF 26.000 for 2015 - 2016, due to the increased costs with a larger number of companies
 - SP proposes that the SP administration cost for the market surveillance for 2013 0 as CHF 45.000 and a maximum of 49.000 for 2014-2015.
 - SP is to prepare a proposal of how to lower the cost of the sticks purchased for 0 the surveillance test.

 - The list of Granted Exemptions has been published on the web page.
- New Certified companies
 - LEXX (SUI) one ball (same as Jolly) and 12 sticks, 4 still under process
 - MEGASAT s.r.o (CZE) one rink
 - Global Sports Cupa (CZE) goal cage and one rink _
 - Acito AB (SWE) two new sticks (Kensis and Eurostick)

6. Marking of products

- Development of pre-sold markings:
 - There are a total of 7000 stickers sold for 2013uptil the end of June
 - The reporting of the self marked products by June 30th shows as follows:
 - Balls 577.691 pcs
 - Sticks 112.752 pcs
 - Goals 620 pcs
 - Rinks 139 pcs
 - Face masks 392 pcs
 - Which is a little less than the figures for last year.
 - All other companies have reported the self marking of the ball for May August, but Jii-Tee Sport and LEXX
 - Only the Cobra and LEXX have not reported the self-printing of the sticks.
 - The production of special stickers for Over-sized sticks has started well.

7. Surveillance Market Control

- The yearly surveillance market control has been started, with focus on sticks and the Face mask ProMask.
- There are some controls made concerning the marking of the sticks and there are some issues, this will be handled later.

8. Material Regulation

- The new MR2014 has been published on the SP web page.
- Interpretations of the stick length SP proposes to approve the marking of the stick length on the knob of the stick.

9. Special issues

- Protective Eye-ware:
- New products approved by Renew (Zone Matrix SR & Unihoc Victory SR)
- Special testing of goalkeeper knee pads and suspensors has been asked for.
