Poland, Olsztyn – group A, 29.04 – 03.05.2015 (170 km from Gdańsk – 2,5 hours by bus) Barczewo – group B, 29.04 – 03.05.2015 (18 km from Olsztyn)

Motivation and objectives for the Local Organiser to organise the event:

Polish Floorball Federation has already organized floorball events such as WFC qualification tournaments, WFC events and we have received very good feedback from the teams participating and excellent notes form IFF after it. In the organization process local authorities are seriously involved; they regard this kind of the event as a chance to promote the local communities. It also vital to the local authorities that some of the players of our national team are inhabitants of Olsztyn community. Last, but not least, Polish national team is participating in the event and it is a great opportunity for the Federation to promote floorball in Olsztyn region and in Poland.

Description of the Political support for the organiser

The authorities of Olsztyna i Barczewa are strongly supporting Polish Federation in organizing the event. The first pre- organizing meeting was already in Olsztyn Community Hall and one of the conclusions in strong desire of Olsztyn and Barczewo to cover most of the costs in the budget.
