## Host Cities / Arenas

### Process

As soon as SUHV will be awarded as Host of the Women's U19 WFC 2016, the federation will launch the bidding process regarding the host city and the local organization committee. Under these circumstances SUHV can present the definite host city latest by mid of 2013.


### Possible Host Cities

SUHV is right now in the bidding process for the next following international and national big Floorball events (Euro Floorball Tour 2013, Euro Champions Cup 2014, Swiss Cupfinals 2014 – 2016). In connection with that we received many interesting applications from host cities and clubs with established experiences in organizing big floorball events. All of them can provide the necessary and well-equipped infrastructure. The following cities / clubs have applied for these events:

- **Zurich** (Grasshopper Club Unihockey / UHC Dietlikon): Saalsporthalle, Sporthalle Hardau (experiences: WFC 2012, EFT 2012 and many national Floorball events)
- **St.Gallen** (UHC Waldkirch St.Gallen): Athletikzentrum, Sporthalle Kreuzbleiche (experiences: EFT 2011, WFC 2011 and several national Floorball events)
- **Jona** (UHC Jona-Uznach Flames): Sporthalle Grünfeld, Turnhallen Rain / Bollwies (experiences: organizer of national team games)
- **Lausanne** (UHC Lausanne): Patinoire de Malley (experiences: national Floorball events)
- **Aigle** (UHC Eagle's): Centre Mondiale du Cyclisme (experiences: national Floorball events)
- **Bern** (Floorball Köniz, Tigers Langnau) : Sporthalle Wankdorf, Espace Arena Biglen, Sporthalle Weissenbühl (experiences : EFT 2012, several Swiss Cupfinals, EFC, WFC 2012, several national Floorball events)
- **Kirchberg/Zuchwil** (SV Wiler-Ersigen) : Sporthalle Grossmatt, Sportzentrum Zuchwil (experiences : EFC, WFC 2012, EFT 2012, several national Floorball events)
- **Schaffhausen** (Kadetten Unihockey): BBC Arena A+B (experiences: national Floorball events; Champions League Handball)

SUHV can assure that all of these potential local organizers would be capable to support the Federation in an appropriate and necessary way to organize a high quality event. Of course this list is not finalized – the race would be still open for additional candidates. But it shows clearly that there are definitely enough interested clubs and cities in Switzerland which are eager and competent enough of organizing an event like that.

### Motivation and objectives for the Local Organiser to organise the event:

- SUHV has a high interest of regularly organizing big international events
- SUHV not only wants to focus on Men / Women WFC but also on youth means U19 events
- SUHV wants to increase the name recognition of floorball in swiss public; after the WFC's 2011/12, the ECC 2014 it is important to have another international highlight as soon as possible
- SUHV is convinced to organize a perfect event with all the made experiences so far
- To keep up with the vision Olympic Games 202X it is important to have regularly international Floorball events in the host country of the IOC

### Description of the Political support for the organiser (brief description, letters of support shall be attached):

The Swiss Olympic Association and the Federal Office of Sport, Maccolin, has awarded their support (see letters of support).  
The support of the local authorities of the host city and host canton can definitely be expected. So far we always run into open doors – and with the cities which are possible Hosts we never had any problems to get the needed support.

### Description of potential problematic conditions in the organiser's country (ability to satisfy 3.2.1-3, 3.2.5 & 3.2.7 of the Guidelines, certificates shall be attached) IFF member countries have to be granted visas for the Event by the organising countries:

We assure that the Women U19 World Floorball Championship will be organised without in any way being restricted by laws, customs or regulations. Switzerland, the host country, will grant the same treatment to teams and competitors from all countries entitled to take part in the event.

### Proposal of the Ticketing system to be used (brief description):

### Number of Volunteers needed (estimated number) and the Structure of the Organisation

Swiss Unihockey will assign a local organising committee which will provide the needed number of volunteers (approx. 500)  
SUHV will have the main responsibility of the event and would host as the central organizer – that means that most of the tasks before the event would be handled through the SUHV office:  
PR/Communication, Marketing, Venue management, Support, Logistics, Tournament administration, Volunteering management.  
The main tasks for the LOC would be to provide the volunteers, to manage the Catering for the public and to handle the administrative and operative works on and off the playing field (match secretariat etc.)

### Number of Venues, size of floor and spectator capacity, number of dressing rooms etc... (description and ability to satisfy 4.3, 4.4 of the Guidelines, certificate to satisfy 4.6 shall be attached):

Switzerland is, by nature, a secure country. Law and order will be maintained by a contingent of the police. Surveillance of the competition sites will be assured by the organizers.

**Medical facilities:**

- In the venues: We will assure stand-by medical assistance services for all participants
- Hospitals: since we will play in a town and the distances in Switzerland are not that long, it will be definitely possible to reach a hospital within a couple of minutes

**Anti-Doping (IFF Anti-Doping Regulations):**

- Doping control room in the venue (Yes/No): Yes
- Local contact to National Anti-Doping Organisation (Yes/No): Yes

**Type of accommodation (price level, number of hotels in the cities, hotel standard):**  
There are several types of accommodation in any price levels in and around all cities in Switzerland. We could easily organize hotels of any range but also youth hostels or military/civil service facilities.

**System of booking (via LOC/Agency or directly):**  
Normally the participants will have the possibility to book their accommodation through the tourist office of the host city – we made pretty well experiences regarding that during the WFC's 2011 and 2012.  
The bookings of military/civil service facilities would be made by SUHV.
