

# **AOFC REPORT AUGUST 2013**

## 1.0 CURRENT MEMBERS STATUS

The AOFC now consists of 13 member countries with the inclusion of Iran and Philippines as members at the 2012 AOFC General Assembly.

A brief overview for each member country as follows

- Australia
  - Held the largest AFO ever with a total of 29 teams with 14 men, 9 women and 6 junior teams
- India.
  - August from 31st to 1st Sept. they are going to conducting Indian Floorball Federation Cup-2013 in Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh) on occasion of Indian Floorball day in India, to celebrate official membership from IFF
  - From 4th Oct. to 6th Oct. 2013 they are going to conduct National Floorball Championship 2013 in Gurgaon (Haryana).
  - India have hosted Bangladesh Floorball official for coaching and have arranged for games between the two countries
