1. FLOORBALL IN AMERICAS BY COUNTRY

BRAZIL

- In January 2014, organized a series of classes and demonstration games in three cities of the State of São Paulo: Santo André, Piracicaba and Santos. 500 people playing (mostly children and teenagers).
- Will launch first junior tournament, focused on children 7-14 years old. Trying to work out the appropriate timing between World Cup and October elections.

- JAMAICA

- Made their debut on the world qualifier stage by competing at the WFCQ2014.
- Continued communication with Special Olympics Canada (Ontario Rep) as they plan to collaborate on hosting of clinics and exchanges to include participation in mini tournaments

- USA

- Anders Buvarp and Michael Borg have been working to put the foundation in place to launch a successful U19 program for the US.
