#### For the IFF Central Board:

In behalf of the floorball community in the Philippines, we would like to request your approval of the change of IFF membership from Floorball Philippines (FP) to Philippine Floorball Association (PFA). Since the conception of floorball in the country in 2011, the sport has been steadily growing in the number of players and clubs which resulted to the need for re-organization of the local floorball community through the establishment of the PFA.

The PFA has been founded by the four pioneering floorball clubs in the Philippines namely UP Floorball Club, UMak Hardy Herons, UA&P Dragons, and De La Salle Zobel last 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2015. The association was officially registered as Philippine Floorball Clubs Association, Inc. on the 11<sup>th</sup> of April 2015 by the Securities and Exchange Commission as a non-stock sport organization. Attached herewith are the copy of the Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws of the association. With the same vision and purpose as FP, the PFA aims to be a well-organized floorball federation that produces world-class and holistic Filipino athletes, coaches, referees and officials in the sport. The mission of the association is the ff.:

- a. to promote, enhance, inculcate to the public and the community the social and health benefits of engaging in floorball.
- b. to instill friendship, camaraderie, and goodwill among the members within and with other related associations.
- c. to undertake or participate in training, seminar, symposium, or lecture series regarding floorball.
- d. to get involve in civic projects or voluntary work to the community.
- e. to participate in various competitions in order to achieve a sense of sportsmanship, and self-confidence among the members and other participants.

During its foundation meeting, the PFA general assembly elected six Board members, who in turn elected from among themselves the Officers and the Eexecutive Committee (ExeCom) heads of the association.
