



IFF Report to CB Meeting June 2019

1.0 Highlights for the AOFC region

- Now 15 members of AOFC
- Floorball officially included in SEA Games 2019 in Philippines
- NZ have applied to hold WFCU19 2022
- Referee and coaching development continues at a strong pace in the region. Referee development seminar to be held in Singapore 25th-28th April for all AOFC members
- Youth development plan being trialled in China with a Standard Test of Floorball Skill Level for Youth being introduced.
- IFF Mentor Coach program launched in New Zealand
- Philippines to hold AOFC Cup 5th – 12th July 2019. 9 teams have registered including Pakistan. The 9 teams are
 - Thailand
 - Singapore
 - Japan
 - Korea
 - Malaysia
 - India
 - Iran
 - Pakistan
 - Philippines
- Coaching and development work continuing in numerous countries in the region
- Kiribati is now a provisional member of IFF and AOFC has approached them to organise them to become a member of AOFC. Response is being waited for
- Thailand appointed as LOC for Indoor Asian Martial Arts Games 2021, with Floorball to be included on the program

2.0 Actions

- Countries have been agreed in principle to propose to the IFF as hosts for
 - WFCQ Men 2020 – Thailand
 - WFCQ Women 2021- Japan
- Meeting at AOFC cup to confirm recommendations on Hosts for the next edition
- Hold a development seminar in SEA region and include Nepal and Bangladesh
- Discuss with Indian Floorball association to take on mentor role with Nepal and Bangladesh
- Continue Project Oceania with a new contact now moved there, NZ have been asked to follow up and mentor them
- Review the IFF Mentor Coach program in NZ
- Continue to push for more Countries to organise Open tournaments in their country
