Q5 Please list 2-3 major achievements of your organisation in the last 3-4 years and explain why they have been a success?

 IFF was for the first time as a medal sport included in the 2017 World Games in Wroclaw, Poland, which was a huge step forward for IFF in our strive to reach the Olympic Games, especially as we were able to build a vast Social Media campaign around the event.
Building World Class World Floorball Championships Events for both Men and Women, with exactly the same set-up. The last two Events with the Women in Bratislava 2017 and the Men's in Prague, Czech Republic, with over 180.000 spectators, with 44 out of 44 matches televised and a total of over 150 broadcasted games in over 15 countries and a broad Social Media coverage.
During the last three years IFF has gained 11 new member countries with six from Africa. IFF now has a total of 70 members. Q6 What are the key issues facing your organisation in the near term which are important for further development?

The main key issue is to secure the inclusion of Floorball into more global and regional multi-sport games, in order to enhance the visibility, awareness and value of Floorball.

The Floorball movement is making a major investigation into the Future Forms of the Game of Floorball until the IFF General Assembly 2020, to determine how the Sport should be played on an international level in the future. Closely related to this the IFF is also evaluating our strategy for 2009 until 2020 and defining the targets and direction for our operations for the period 2021 to 2032. From a sporting perspective the most important task is to find ways closing the gap on the field of play between on the one hand the Top 4 and the top 5-12 and then the gap between the top 20-40 and the rest of the member associations.
