

## **IFF Information Function report October 2012**

#### **IFF Website & stats:**

- January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012 October 23<sup>rd</sup> 2012 website statistics compared with January 1<sup>st</sup> 2011 October 23rd 2012.
- The Champions Cup website affects the stats in October 2012 (separate CC page statistics)



• 535 947 visits from 165 countries January 1st 2012 – October 23<sup>rd</sup> 2012 (compared to 475 065 visits in 2011).

## **Champions Cup Website & Stats**

- The Champions Cup 2012 website was the first official IFF event website that is launched with a new model, where the official website is under the IFF domain. The aim of the new concept was to have all tournament information gathered in one place (instead of having a LOC CC page and IFF CC page).
- The tournament page included easy access to the game results and statistics and in addition to all the relevant newsfeeds from the participating nations, clubs and commercial floorball websites of the participating countries. The main IFF website links were also included on the website since the CC website was the IFF front page during the CC tournament.
- The IFF has asked for feedback from the LOC and received comments from three LOC media team persons:
  - The web page really looked great and it was easy to find what you were looking for. It was a good cooperation! (LOC 1).
  - I can only agree. The technical bits worked smoothly and I think we already in the first day found an efficient way of working where we could quickly deliver news, pictures and videos. It was good that we got all the instructions a few weeks in advance so we could familiarise ourselves with how everything works. The only thing I possibly missing was a similar template for how to match texts should look like. Certainly a detail, but it can be useful to determine the news layout in advance so that all texts look the same. Happy with the cooperation! (LOC 2).
  - For web-collaboration, I agree that everything worked very well. We could have had more templated texts, so that everyone's texts would have looked exactly the same, but I think that could have been a little boring. As we worked now was good. (LOC 3).


