Report on present issues

1. Objective and set-up

During the AOFC Central Board meeting in Korea, during the APAC 2009, it was agreed, based on the good progress in the region and in order for AOFC to start actively spreading the sport based from Asia, that the IFF Development function will arrange a workshop for 3-4 potential instructors from each of the AOFC member federations, in order to train regional instructors for development work. The participants were to have a good knowledge of Floorball in the different fields. The objective of the workshop was to train regional instructors, so that IFF then could use these in potential regional development seminars and in country specific seminars. The workshop was held in Singapore, organized in co-operation with the Singapore federation.

2. Workshop program

The workshop was opened by Mr. Orlando expressing the need to have a panel consisting of regional instructors, educated to follow the guidelines of the IFF. In order to globally develop Floorball there can only be one way of doing it – which is the IFF way. The Development work has to be driven and steered by IFF.

During the workshop, the objectives, the structure and the actual program of the seminar was analysed and the way to set up a seminar was discussed in both pairs and in working groups. The participants then discussed the different blocks and the different topics on the seminar, defining what is most important for developing countries, making demonstration presentations of how the topics could be presented.

The workshop ended in a practical training, where the participants presented drills they had made for a specific part of the training.

3. Outcome of the workshop

Due to the large number of Singaporean participants, the way the workshop was conducted had to be changed, losing some of the original idea, where more time would have been spent on in-depth discussions with the participants.

Overall the workshop proved to work very well and it will help to form a regional panel.
