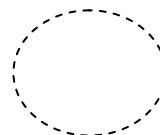

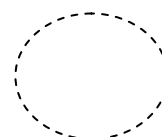

This is also a good way of promoting women's Floorball for those who are interested in coaching. The focus will be on group works, analysing and discussions.**

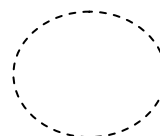
